Enrollment Qualifications for Horizons

The three year old program is for children who have turned 3 by September 30. The four year old/Pre-K program is for children who have turned 4 by September 30. All students must be toilet trained and their immunizations need to be up to date.

Enrollment Procedures

You and your child may arrange a tour of the school and observe a class by calling Joan Filips. To register your child, an enrollment form must be completed and returned with a non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00 and a \$25.00 partial tuition payment for the first month of school.

Current Horizons Preschool students and siblings will have registration priority before open enrollment. During the open enrollment period, class rosters will be filled based on the receipt date of the enrollment form and the fees. Open enrollment will begin January 25. Fees will be returned if your student cannot be enrolled. Confirmation of your child's enrollment will be mailed to you.

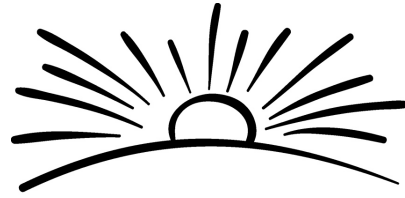
