Enrollment Qualifications for Horizons

The three-year-old program is for children who have turned 3 by September 30. The 4 year old program is for children who have turned 4 by September 30, and 5 year old program for those that need an extra year of preschool.

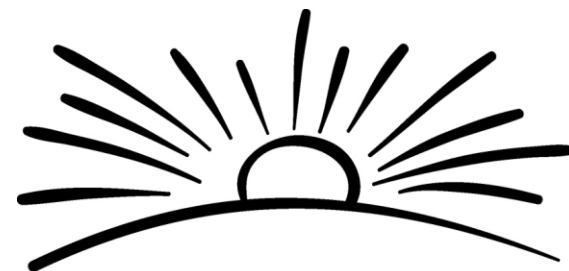
All students must be toilet trained and up to date on immunizations.

Enrollment Procedures

You and your child may arrange a tour of the school and observe a class by calling Angie Racine. To register your child, an enrollment form must be completed and returned with a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00/\$75.00/\$100.00 depending on how many days per week session.

Current Horizons Preschool students and siblings will have registration priority before open enrollment. During the open enrollment period, class rosters will be filled based on the receipt date of the enrollment form and the fees. Fees will be returned if your student cannot be enrolled. Confirmation of your child's enrollment will be mailed to you.

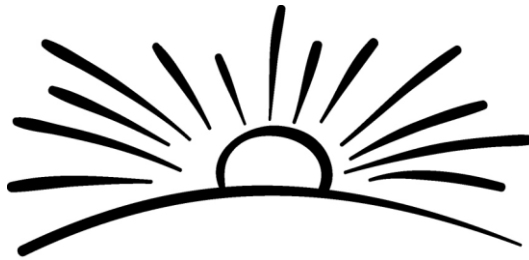
